



General Precautions for Interior Treatment Ants, Carpet Beetles and General Pest Control

- Cover or refrigerate edible products
- Remove pets, their food and water bowls, and toys away from area that is to be treated
- Remove all children's toys from floor
- Plan applications at times when premises won't be occupied. If possible plan to stay away for a few hours afterwards (Minimum of four hours is a good general rule)
- Move items away from area being treated
- Ventilate as much as possible during and following pesticide application
- Do not walk on or touch the treated area until it is dry
- Residence must be free of excess clutter so technicians will be able to service properly
- Rugs and floors should be vacuumed before treatment for fleas
